## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

for the

## 2015 Amelia Lapeña Bonifacio Literary Contest (Short Story, Poetry, Creative Nonfiction, and the Critical Essay)

## sponsored by the Department of English and Comparative Literature

- The contest is open to bona-fide undergraduate and graduate students of U.P. Diliman enrolled in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of AY 2014-2015. The contest is not open to faculty members of the English Department.
- 2. Authors may submit not more than 2 entries in each category.
- 3. The author must submit the following documents in a sealed long brown envelope: (a) one (1) original and three (3) copies of his/her entry, without author's name; (b) on a separate sheet of paper, the author's full name and contact information; and (3) a photocopy of his/her Form 5 for the 2nd semester AY 2014-2015. The title of the entry and the category should be written or typed on the envelope.
- 4. Only unpublished works may be entered.
- Only works which have not won a prize in another contest may be entered.
- 6. In the short story category, an entry must be not more than 20 pages in length.
- 7. In the poetry category, an entry must consist of at least 5 poems.
- 8. In the creative nonfiction category, an entry must be not more than 20 pages in length.
- 9. In the critical essay category, an entry must be not more than 20 pages in length.
- 10. All entries must be written in English.
- 11. Entries may be on any subject or theme except for the critical essay the topic of which is limited to Philippine literature in English.

- 12. The author shall retain ownership of the copyright to his/her award-winning work. However, the sponsor shall have the right to first publication. Editors designated by the sponsor may edit portions of the work to suit the demands of publication.
- 13. The prize will be withdrawn from any author found to have plagiarized his/her winning entry entirely or in part.
- 14. Entries must be addressed and submitted to Dr. Lily Rose R. Tope, Department of English and Comparative Literature (DECL), Bulwagang Rizal, UP Diliman not later than January 23, 2015.
- 15. All entries should be typewritten or computerized, double spaced, on 8½ x 11 inches bond paper, with one-inch margin on all sides. If computerized, the font must be Arial or Times New Roman and the font size 12.
- 16. The Board of Judges shall have the discretion not to award any prize if, in its judgment, no meritorious entry has been submitted.
- 17. The sponsor has the sole right to designate the persons who shall constitute the Board of Judges in each of the categories.
- 18. The names of the winners and the names of the Board of Judges shall be announced in February 2015.
- All parties submitting an entry are deemed to have accepted the rules of the contest, and agree to abide thereby.
