Departmental Elective: Any course numbered 100 and above other than CL.

Free Elective: Any course numbered 100 or above in other disciplines outside of the DECL.

\*\* If a transferee has already taken a Math course in her/his previous course/University, Math 2 need not be prescribed anymore.
