NOTES

As a requirement for graduation, all students must take (6) units in one of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officers' Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD. NSTP 1 & 2 must be taken in the same college.

Language Requirement: Students should take 12 units of a European, Asian or Philippine language to be determined by their area of concentration.

CL Concentration Courses: The student should take 12 units within their area of concentration; may take CL 198 (Selected Topics course in the particular area of concentration).

CL Elective: Any CL course numbered 100 and above, including courses offered by other CL areas of concentration.

Departmental Elective: Any course numbered 100 and above other than CL.

Free Elective: Any course numbered 100 or above in other disciplines outside of the DECL.

** If a transferee has already taken a Math course in her/his previous course/University, Math 2 need not be prescribed anymore.
