Foreign Language Examination Requirement: The student must pass a reading examination in **TWO (2) European languages** – French, German and/or any other language/s approved by her/his program adviser.

The Language Proficiency Exam **can be taken by the doctoral student only after s/he has passed the Qualifying Examinations, after which s/he can take the LPEs any time during the student's remaining course work, as long as she deems him/herself ready for this exam, and with the consent of her/his program adviser.** The LPE is administered by the Department of European Languages once every semester (please check with the CAL Graduate Studies Office regarding the date of the exam.).
