²As a requirement for graduation, all students must take six (6) units in one of the National Service Training Program (NSTP) components: Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), Literacy Training Service (LTS), and Reserved Officers' Training Corps Military Science (ROTC Mil Sci). These are offered by UPD. NSTP 1 & 2 must be taken in the same college.

Concentration Courses

For the 21 units of concentration courses, students may choose from any of the following: CW 110, 111, 120, 121, 130, 131, 140, 141, 150, 151, 180, 190, 198

Prerequisites

Student must decide which three genres (6 units per genre or 18 units) s/he wishes to focus on, and take as prerequisite to those courses, the relevant CL genre course (e.g., if s/he chooses CW 110 and 111- Fiction I and Fiction II, s/he must take CL 111 as a prerequisite; if s/he chooses CW 140 and CW 141- Creative Non-fiction I and Creative Non-fiction II, he/she must take CL 115 as a prerequisite.) One concentration course (3 units) will have no prerequisite.

If a transferee has already taken a Math course in her/his previous course/University, Math 2 need not be prescribed anymore.

The University regularly reviews course curricula and may revise them. Students admitted into this program shall follow the existing curriculum until such time that a new curriculum replacing it has been duly approved for implementation. All courses prescribed and taken under this existing curriculum shall be credited under the new curriculum.
